


SETTING UP OUTLOOK 2010


STEP 1. Open Outlook. Click on FILE > INFO



STEP 2. Choose ADD ACCOUNT if you are setting up email for the first time

or chose ACCOUNT SETTING
if modifying existing account

(then go to page 7 of this tutorial)



STEP 3. Select E-MAIL ACCOUNT and fill out information—click NEXT


Verify these tabs are correct.



Click on the Outgoing Server tab,

Check the box labeled **My outgoing server (SMTP) requires authentication**. Then choose to **Use same settings as my incoming mail server**






Click on the Advanced tab.

- Under **Incoming Server (POP3)**, the port number should be set to **995**. CHECK the SSL box
- Under **Outgoing Server (SMTP)**, the port number should be set to **465**.

Click **OK**

Click **Next**. Click **Finish**.




Make sure This Server Requires an encrypted connection (SSL) is checked
